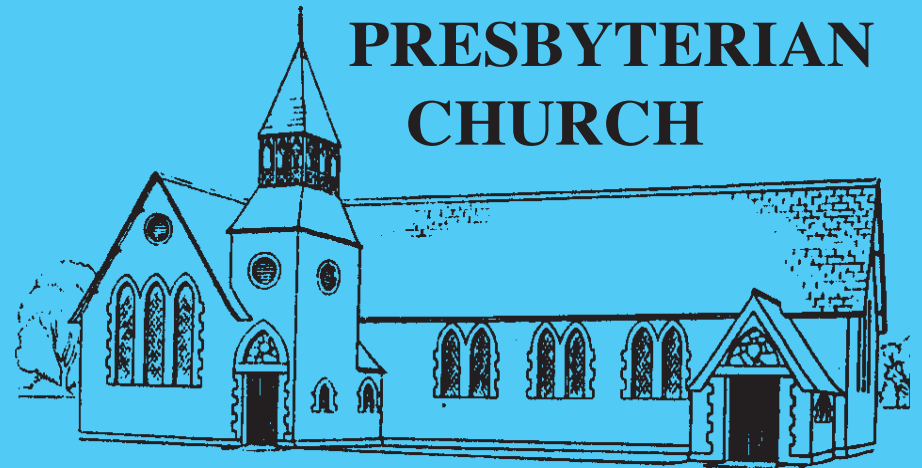

So let's be patient people and remember to give thanks constantly. As we begin another Autumn's work let's serve obediently and enthusiastically, always prepared to share the hope we have in Jesus.
