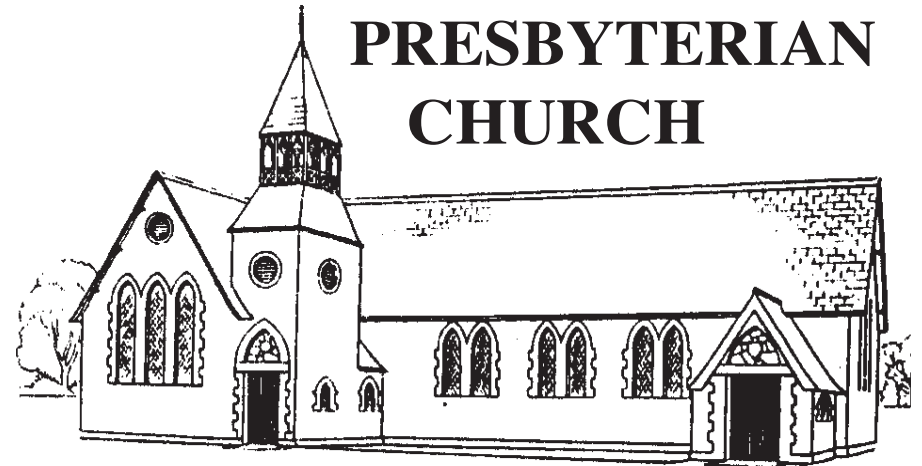
**Used Stamps:** Box at the back of the church to collect used stamps
