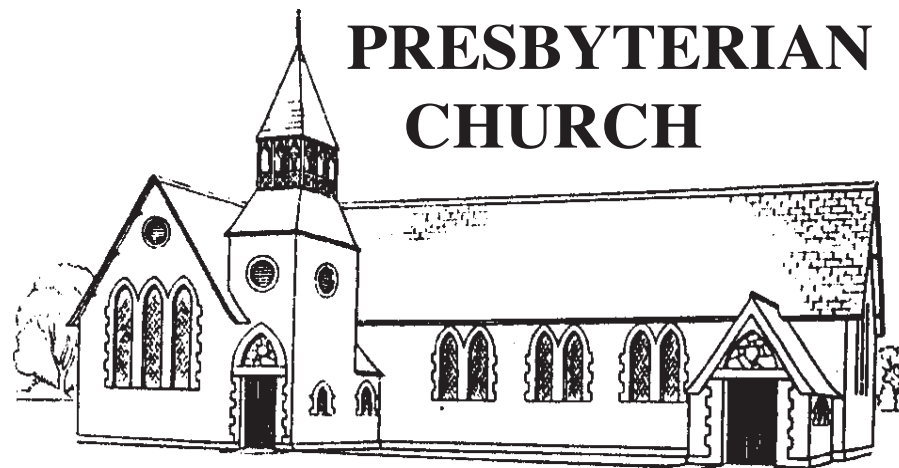
LARNE FOODBANK: Items for this month: red/brown sauce, sauce for curry, long grain rice, tinned fruit, soap and toothpaste.
