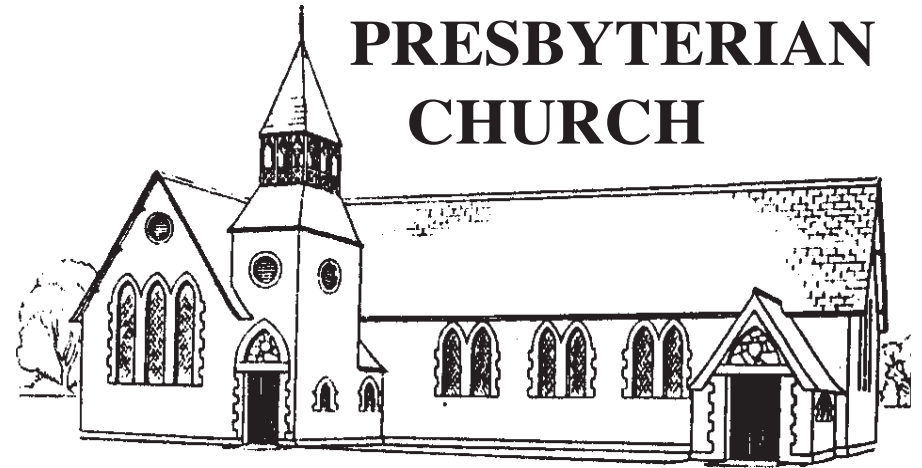
Envelopes returned to the collection points in Larne were counted into the Larne total which was £9119.46. This figure does not include the gift aid donations that will be added.
