### SHOEBOX APPEAL

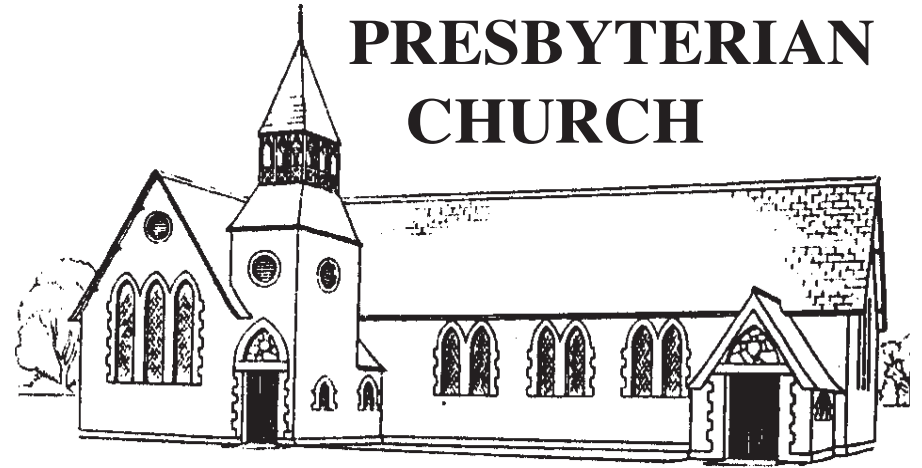
Leaflets are at the back of the church for those who wish to support this appeal.
