### HARVEST ARRANGEMENTS

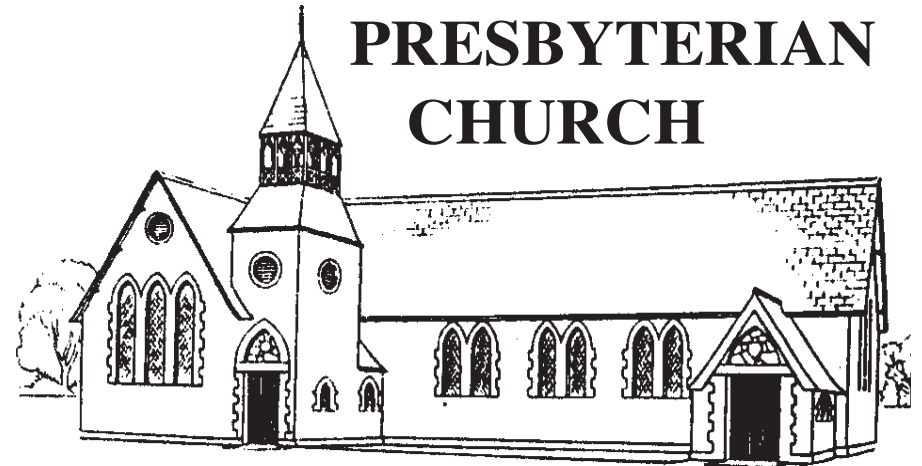
